

Is your child no longer a student dependant?

If your child or children have left school or started working they may no longer be eligible to receive health cover under your membership.

They will need to purchase their own health cover membership to ensure they are protected against costs of treatment in the event of accidents, sporting injury or illness.

If they take out their own health cover with Australian Unity within three months of their eligibility ceasing on your membership, they will receive continuity of benefits at an equivalent or lower level of cover. If they apply after three months, standard waiting periods will apply.

For continuity of benefits to apply, your child's cover must start from the date they become ineligible to be covered as a student dependant under the family membership.

Australian Unity members also get even more for their health cover with our Wellness benefits. Wellness benefits are a series of preventative health programs that you can use every day, not just when you get sick. Student Dependant Membership Registration

If you have a family membership with Australian Unity, your children are automatically covered until they turn 23 years of age, at no extra cost, regardless of whether they are employed or studying. When your children turn 23, they can still be covered under your family cover as student dependant(s)* until the age of 25, as long as they are not married or living in a defacto relationship and pursuing an approved full-time course of study†.

Therefore, if your child or children are between 23 and 25 years of age and are continuing with their studies, simply complete and return the attached Student Dependant Registration form to Australian Unity. If your child or children are eligible, registering their student dependant status will ensure full continuity for their current health cover benefits.

* **Student Dependant:** any person who is related to a member who contributes at the family health cover rate being that member's unmarried child, legally adopted child or stepchild aged between 23 and 25 years and who is pursuing an approved full-time course of study† at school, college or university.

† **Approved course of study:** secondary and tertiary academic study, trade apprenticeships and industry, employer or government training schemes, **provided that** the course of study results upon completion in the Student Dependant being qualified to seek or maintain gainful employment in the general workforce and that the Dependant is not, or will not remain, dependent upon the Contributor for personal care, domestic or social support after having attended the course of study.
